

Yathra (Journey) evokes an abstract expression of the cycle of one day, metaphorically tracing a human being's journey from the dawn of birth to the twilight of life. It is a visual meditation of the human experience, deeply exploring the spiritual and emotional passage of a soul through the many phases of life—birth, youth, love, loss, redemption, and death, completing the cycle with re-birth. A collaborative work with Ragamala Music and Dance Theater(www.ragamala.net), composers Shubhendra Rao on Sitar and Saskia Rao on her Indian Cello convey the fullness of an entire orchestra---a sound as evocative and rich as life's journey.
